Local

The L.O.L. dolls were so popular because of the brand's brilliant and innovative social media and marketing methods. M.G.A Entertainment Company, who make the dolls, integrated social media in promoting the dolls to benefit their target clients. Children watched videos on YouTube of other children opening the surprise dolls. The videos were popular because children enjoyed the anticipation without being afraid. They knew roughly what would be in the package, just not the exact details. Years ago, children's toys were advertised in the commercial breaks of popular television programmes and children knew the difference between programmes and adverts. Today, social media has blurred these lines so children do not know if they are watching an advert or a programme.

National

In 1999, Lego started to sell licensed products, which they hadn't done before and this opened up a whole new world of play experiences by bringing in all these other brands.
